

## 2018-2019 CHCS School Supplies for 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students

- Three (3) College-Ruled composition notebooks** (100 pages) [for English, history, Latin]
- One (1) package of or composition notebook full of graph paper (quadrille)**—4 squares per inch [for Algebra I only]
- Two (2) 2-inch binder(s)** (to keep notes, handouts, etc. for English, Latin, math, science, history, Bible, and logic), separated by subject with a page protector and each subject separated with tabbed dividers (see next two items)
- Tab dividers** (you'll need about 15 total tabs) It's suggested, but not mandatory, that you purchase the tabs which have pockets, since pockets can be helpful to you for organizational purposes.
- One (1) package page protectors** (at least 10)
- One (1) package of EXPO markers (fine tip)** for use with individual white board review
- Suggested: an accordion file, folder(s), or other way to help manage homework papers and papers that need to be filed.** (What you decide to use can be based on your own personal organizational style. However, you need to have a system for where you will put the assignments you are currently working on, but are not yet complete. And, you need to decide where you will place completed assignments. When it is time to turn in an assignment, you shouldn't be "hunting" for paper(s) and should know exactly where the assignment is.)
- Ti-83, Ti-84 Plus, or Ti-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator:** The graphing calculator is expensive—about \$100-\$120; however, it will serve a student's needs through all of his/her high school science and math courses. If it's taken care of, it will even be useful in college math courses, too! To find deals, wait for "back-to-school" specials or shop on Ebay/Amazon.
- Bible**—any translation; this Bible will be kept in the student's backpack and available for use in all classes. It doesn't need to be a new Bible.

The following supplies are needed for use in all classes. Most of them are consumable, so please keep these on hand at your house so you can restock as needed throughout the year. Students are expected to have these supplies with them every day.

- College-ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper** (always need about a package on hand)
- Pens** (black/blue) (always need a couple of these on hand)
- Pencils** (any kind) (always need a couple of these on hand)
- Eraser** (preferably the white polymer eraser)
- Grading pens (at least one red** plus other acceptable colors—green, purple, pink, etc.)
- Highlighters** (at least two on hand; preferred colors are yellow and pink)
- Colored pencils** (12-count package)
- Glue sticks**
- Small, hand-held pencil sharpener**
- Scissors** (approx. 7-inch)
- Sharpie markers** (fine-tip—at least two on hand)
- 3 x 5 lined index cards** (start with a package of 100) stored in a Ziploc bag or index card box [needed for both English and Physical Science]
