CURRICULAR DISTINCTIVES

CHCS adheres to the classical Trivium of grammar, dialectic, and rhetoric. Specific to the rhetoric stage, all students participate in Socratic debates of moral, philosophical, political, and theological nature. **All seniors are required to write and orally defend a thesis that showcases skills in research, critical thinking, writing, and speaking.** A primary goal at Christian Heritage is to develop well-rounded students who are equipped with skills that will enable them to be articulate, discerning, and effective members of their communities.
