

The Speech Meet selections are available on the CHCS website and can be found under the Parent/CHCS Resources tab. Please help your student with the following:

1. Choose the desired category: Bible memorization, poetry, fable/folklore, or literary prose.
2. Pick **three** selections from the chosen category *in order of preference*. Students will not be able to recite the same piece as a classmate.
3. Record the choices *in order of preference* on the selection form and return by **December 11**. If there are duplicate requests, we will “draw straws” to see who gets which piece and notify your student on Monday.
4. Please work with your student on memorizing the selection. The selection must be memorized by January 15.

**Literary Prose:** This category is designed to include classic passages or essays from great authors such as Lewis, Tolkien, Dickens, Twain, and more. We have provided several passages from which you may choose, but you may also select a passage from your favorite classic. The guidelines are:

4<sup>th</sup> grade      8 lines minimum

If you are choosing your own passage, selections must be approved by your student’s teacher by **December 7**.

**Guidelines:**

Before the students say their piece, they should state the title and author’s name. For the Bible category, students should state the reference and translation and then recite the verses.
