- Coach singles and doubles players in technical, tactical, and mental aspects of competition
- Determine lineups and doubles pairings based on performance, team needs, and program standards
- Prepare student-athletes to compete at a high level in district and postseason play
- Compete to win while remaining fully aligned with CHCS values

- Communicate clearly, consistently, and professionally
- Serve as a positive and dependable influence in the lives of student-athletes
- Work closely with the CHCS Athletic Department regarding scheduling, transportation, facilities, and program needs
