	ONE (1) pair of scissors (approx. 7-8 inches; small enough to fit in a zipper pouch)
	ONE (1) package of page protectors (need about 25 of them)
	ONE (1) ruler (must have centimeters AND inch increments)
	ONE (1) 12-count colored pencils (or larger count) (to be available for all classes)
	<b>ONE (1) calculator</b> (This should be a very basic, inexpensive calculator. Inexpensive means that
	you do not need to spend more than \$5.00 and you probably can find one for \$1.00.)
	ONE (1) pair of ear buds or headphones that will stay at school and be available for computer
	projects in each of your classes
	ONE (1) small hand-held pencil sharpener with shaving receptacle
	<b>Bible:</b> You need a backpack-sized Bible to take to all your classes. This may be any version that
	you prefer. For your Bible class, you will be provided with a specific ESV study Bible, but this will
	stay in Mrs. Sieh's classroom
	<b>HIGHLY RECOMMENDED</b> : Locker organizational items for INSIDE the locker only, including a 12-
	inch-wide locker shelf. No lock for the locker is needed.
The fo	llowing supplies are <u>needed throughout the year in each class</u> . Please keep a supply of these on
	n the locker or at home to replenish as needed. These are the supplies students are expected to

	College-ruled, NOT WIDE-RULED, loose-leaf notebook filler paper (start with at least 500
	sheets)
	Pencils (may be mechanical or not) (start with two or three—extras may be stored in locker)
	<b>Eraser</b> (preferably a white, hi-polymer eraser because this erases more cleanly, but any eraser
	will do) (start with one or two)
	Pens (blue/black ink only) (start with two or three)
	Pens for grading (red) (start with two or three)
	Fine-Tipped Black Sharpie (start with one or two)
	Glue sticks (start with three or four)
	Tape (transparent rolls of tape) (start with two or three rolls)
	Highlighters (start with two or three—same or assorted colors—at least one yellow)
	Expo markers (start with at least two)

In 6<sup>th</sup> grade, we use a particular folder & composition notebook system to aid the students with organization as they transition into middle school. Because we need the students to have exact colors for this, **we will bill the parents a \$10** school supply fee to cover the items needed. By doing so, we will also save the parents much time and some money because we can buy these items in bulk. These items will be placed in the students' lockers, so they are available to the student during 6<sup>th</sup>-Grade Orientation on August 11.
