$\square$ Three (3) college-ruled composition notebooks (80+ sheets) [English, Latin, and Science]
$\square$ Four (4) 2-inch binder(s) These may be any color, but should be durable enough for heavy use; one for Logic/Bible; one for English/Latin; one for Science/Math; one for History
$\square$ Tab dividers (you'll need about 20 total dividers) It's suggested, but not mandatory, that you purchase the tabs which have pockets, since pockets can be helpful to you for organization.
$\square$ One (1) package of at least 10 page protectors

- Suggested/optional: an accordion file, pocket folder, or some other way to help manage homework papers (What you decide to use can be based on your own personal organizational style. However, you need to have a system for where you will put the assignments you are currently working on but are not yet complete. You also need to decide where you will place completed assignments that need to be turned in. When it is time to turn in an assignment, you will be expected to know exactly where the assignment is. ©)
$\square$ Calculator: Any OR Ti-83, Ti-84 Plus, or Ti-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator (The graphing calculator is required for students taking $7^{\text {th }}$ Pre-Algebra, but not for those taking $7^{\text {th }}$ Math. In $8^{\text {th }}$ grade, all students will need this calculator. We know that this graphing calculator is expensive-about $\$ 120$; however, it will serve a student's needs for all of his/her high school science and math courses, too. If it's taken care of, it may also be used in college. To find deals, wait for "back-to-school" specials or shop on Ebay/Amazon. Be sure you put your student's name on the calculator before sending it to school.) In lieu of the graphing calculator, $7^{\text {th }}$ Math students may purchase a basic 5 -function calculator.
- ONE (1) pair of ear buds or headphones that will stay at school and be available for computer projects in each of your classes
$\square$ ONE (1) ruler (must have centimeters AND inch increments)
$\square$ ONE (1) 12-count colored pencils (or larger count)
$\square$ ONE (1) small hand-held pencil sharpener with shaving receptacle
$\square$ ONE (1) pair of scissors (approx. 7-8 inches; small enough to fit in a zipper pouch)
- ONE (1) zippered pencil pouch or something like this to hold pens, pencils, scissors, etc. This will be kept in the student's backpack as the student travels from class to class.
$\square$ Bible-any translation the student prefers; this Bible will be kept in the student's backpack and available for use in all classes. It doesn't need to be a new Bible.
$\square$ HIGHLY RECOMMENDED: Locker organizational items for INSIDE the locker only, including a 12-inch-wide locker shelf. No lock for the locker is needed.

The following supplies are needed for use in all classes. Most of them are consumable, so please keep these on hand at your house or in the locker so you can restock as needed throughout the year. Students are expected to have these supplies with them every day.
$\square$ College-ruled, NOT WIDE-RULED, loose-leaf notebook filler paper (start with at least 500 sheets)

- Pencils (may be mechanical or not) (start with two or three-extras may be stored in locker)

I Eraser (preferably a white, hi-polymer eraser because these erase more cleanly, but any eraser will do) (start with one or two)
$\square$ Pens (blue/black ink only) (start with two or three)
$\square$ Pens for grading (red) (start with two or three)
$\square$ Fine-tipped black sharpie (start with one or two)
$\square$ Glue sticks (start with three or four)
$\square$ Tape (transparent rolls of tape) (start with two or three)
$\square$ Highlighters (start with two or three-same or assorted colors-at least one yellow)

- Expo markers (to use in classes for white board review) (start with at least two)
