$\square$ Two (2) or college-ruled composition notebooks (80+ sheets) [English and Latin]
$\square$ Four (4) 2-inch binder(s)—May be any color but should be durable enough for heavy use. One is specifically for History. The remaining three will be shared between all your classes.
$\square$ Tab dividers (you'll need about 20 total dividers)

- One (1) package of at least 10 page protectors
- Ti-83, Ti-84 Plus, or Ti-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator: The graphing calculator is expensive-about \$120; however, it will serve a student's needs through all of his/her high school science and math courses. If it's taken care of, it will even be useful in college math courses, too! To find deals, wait for "back-to-school" specials or shop on eBay.
$\square$ ONE (1) Pair of earbuds or headphones (inexpensive) that will stay at school for computer use
$\square$ ONE (1) ruler (must have centimeters AND inch increments)
$\square$ ONE (1) 12-count colored pencils (or larger count)
$\square$ ONE (1) small hand-held pencil sharpener with shaving receptacle
- ONE (1) pair of scissors (approx. 7-8 inches; small enough to fit in a zipper pouch)
- ONE (1) zippered pencil pouch or something like this to hold pens, pencils, scissors, etc. This will be kept in the student's backpack as the student travels from class to class.
$\square$ Bible-any translation the student prefers; this Bible will be kept in the student's backpack and available for use in all classes. It doesn't need to be a new Bible.
$\square$ Suggested: an accordion file, pocket folder, or some other way to help manage homework papers
$\square$ HIGHLY RECOMMENDED: Locker organizational items for INSIDE the locker only, including a 12-inch-wide locker shelf. No lock for the locker is needed.

The following supplies are needed for use in all classes. Most of them are consumable, so please keep these on hand at your house or in the locker so you can restock as needed throughout the year. Students are expected to have these supplies with them every day.
$\square$ College-ruled, NOT WIDE-RULED, loose-leaf notebook filler paper (start with at least 500 sheets)

- Pencils (may be mechanical or not) (start with two or three-extras may be stored in locker)
$\square$ Eraser (preferably a white, hi-polymer eraser because these erase more cleanly, but any eraser will do) (start with one or two)
- Pens (blue/black ink only) (start with two or three)
$\square$ Pens for grading (at least one red plus other acceptable colors-green, purple, pink, etc.)
$\square$ Fine-tipped black sharpie (start with one or two)
$\square$ Glue sticks (start with three or four)
- Tape (transparent rolls of tape) (start with two or three)
$\square$ Highlighters (start with two or three-same or assorted colors-at least one yellow)
$\square$ Expo markers (to use in classes for white board review) (start with at least two)
$\square 3 \times 5$ lined index cards (start with a package of 100) stored in a Ziploc bag or index card box
